What is respite night?

Parents can drop of their child(ren) with special needs (up to age 21) along with their siblings (through age 13), while background checked volunteers care for them. Kids will enjoy a variety of activities throughout the evening. Pre-registration is required.

What will the children do?

Kids will get to enjoy a variety of activities that include bounce houses, games and activities. We will also provide a quiet room for kids that need a break!

Will dinner be served?
