

GREAT MINDS THINK ALIKE

Divide your family into two groups and give everyone a sheet of paper and a pen. Call out a category and ask them to secretly write down the first three things that come to mind. When everyone is done, read the words to your team members and award a point for every word written down multiple times. When your family gets to 10 points, you all have won! Play again as many times as you would like.

You can go as broad or detailed as you think would make the game fun for your family. Here are a few category ideas: something you would find on the side of the road, a famous person with a mustache, a yellow cartoon character, a fictional animal, or something sweet.

PAINT ROCKS

Cover a table with newspaper or magazines. Give each participant a thin paper plate with two rocks on it. Encourage the children to paint both rocks. Then, let the child paint a cross on top of the rock. Have the child draw a circle around the rock they want to keep and write their name on the paper plate. Give the rocks time to dry. Take the rocks that are NOT circled and hide them in different places in your community. Write your church name and "Jesus Loves You" on the bottom of each rock with a permanent fine-tipped marker.

Say: You painted two rocks today. One is for you to keep, and we will hide the other outside for someone to find. When people find the rock with the cross on it, they will think about Jesus and remember that Jesus loves them. Paul told people about Jesus even when he was in prison, and people wanted to hurt him. We can tell people that Jesus loves them by hiding the rocks we painted.
