

MESSAGE UNDER A PLATE

How to play: Before your family sits down for dinner, write sentences on slips of paper and place them under each of their dinner plates (each family member should have a different sentence). The sentences should be silly but not nonsensical — for example, "Wish I was the first man on the moon." or "Have you ever tried ostrich eggs?" After everyone sits down at the table, have them silently read the piece of paper under their plate. As soon as everyone memorizes their sentence, they must attempt to slip it into conversation during dinner without the other members noticing. If one person is called out by another, he or she is out. The first person to use their phrase and go undetected wins, but it's fun to keep playing until all the players have said their sentences.

COLLAGE TIME

As a family, walk outside and look for various items—leaves, grass, flowers, twigs, etc. Place the container of nature items and a pair of child-safe scissors on the table. Invite kids to practice their cutting skills by cutting the grass and leaves. Your kids may enjoy gluing their cuttings on construction paper to make a collage!

Sav: You cut several items found in nature. Grass, leaves, and flowers all grow here on earth. John had a vision of Jesus and what will happen in the future. John saw a new heaven and a new earth. - A: (Adoration) Lord, we acknowledge that you...
- C: (Confession) We confess that we have sinned and need your forgiveness.
- T: (Thanksgiving) God, we thank you for...
- S: (Supplication) We humbly ask that you...
